# FRANKLIN COUNTY RECYCLING

- **Special Waste**

- Waste Oil & Waste Antifreeze: Used oil ( OIL MUST BE OIL ONLY AND NOT CONTAIN ANY GAS, WATER OR ANTIFREEZE) and antifreeze is collected for recycling at Franklin County Solid Waste Management located on Joyce Lane in Winchester and at the following Convenience Centers: Alto, Capital Hill, Center Grove, Cowan, Estill Springs, Lexie Crossroads, Old Salem, Sewanee and Winchester Springs
- Don't clog up your pipes and sewer lines; take your used cooking oil to 419 Joyce Lane.

- **Construction and Demolition and Large Items:**

- **Bulky Items** such as furniture, TVs, mattress, etc. can be disposed at Franklin County Solid Waste Management on Joyce Lane in Winchester or at BFI.
- **\*Construction and Demolition Waste:** must be disposed at the BFI transfer station on Hwy. 41A in Estill Springs.

- **Paints and Chemicals**

- Household Hazardous Waste Event will be held each year at Franklin County Solid Waste Management on Joyce Lane in Winchester. The event is for the proper disposal of household and garden chemicals, oil based paint, batteries, electronics, fluorescent light bulbs, and mercury thermostats and thermometers. - Latex Paint: Usable paint can be donated and old unusable paint can be filled with kitty litter/sand for drying and disposed in your regular garbage.
