Requirements for Voter Registration in the State of Tennessee:

- You must be a citizen of the United States.
- •You must be a least eighteen (18) years old on/or before the next election.
- You must have never been convicted of a felony, or have been pardoned by a Governor, U.S. President, or other appropriate authority of a state or have had full rights of citizenship restored.

Knowingly giving false information to register to vote or attempting to register when not qualified is a felony punishable by not less than two (2) years nor more than twelve (12) years imprisonment or a fine of \$5,000 or both.

Voting by Mail

If you are unable to appear at your polling place on Election Day or during the Early Voting period, you may request an absentee ballot to be mailed to you for one of the following reasons:

- 1. I am 60 years of age or older.
- 2. I will be outside of my county during all hours of early voting and on Election Day.
- 3. I am hospitalized, ill or physically disabled and unable to appear at my polling place to vote.
- 4. I am a caretaker of a hospitalized, ill or physically disabled person.
- 5. I am a full-time student or spouse of a full-time student outside my county.
- I reside in a licensed facility, outside my county, providing relatively permanent domiciliary care, i.e. Nursing Home.
- 7. I am a candidate for office in the election.
- I am observing a religious holiday that prevents me from voting during early voting or on Election Day.
- I will be serving as an election official or a member or employee of the election commission on Election Day.
- 10. I will be serving on jury duty.
- 11. I am a voter with a disability and my polling place is inaccessible.
- 12. I have a CDL or TWIC or I am a spouse of a person with a CDL or TWIC and will be out of the county during early voting and Election Day.

- 4. Date of Birth
- 5. Address to mail ballot to
- 6. Election type-include party for primaries
- 7. Voter's Signature
- 8. Reason for Request
