Specific Information

Previous Actions: This parcel is a combination of four parcels on Franklin County Tax Map 15; 43.00, 44.00, 46.02 and 47.00. On 3/17/1997 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners approved a request to rezone parcel 47.00 to R-1, Single Family. On 11/17/2009 a Minor Division of Property was approved to create a separate 3.15+/-acre lot. On 8/5/2014 a Minor Division of Property was approved to create a separate .50+/- acre lot. On 7/7/2015 a Minor Division of Property was approved creating a non-buildable lot of .17+/-acres to be added to parcel 44.04 on Franklin County Tax Map No. 15. On 8/2/2016 a Minor Division of Property was approved creating a separate 2.61+/-acre lot. On 6/25/2020 a Minor Division of Property was approved creating a .13+/- acre non-buildable lot to be

added to the approved Minor Division from 8/12/2016. On 6/21/23 a Minor Division of Property was approved creating a separate .94+/- acre lot. On 1/20/2010 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners approved a request to rezone a portion of parcel 47.00 to C, Commercial. On 5/5/2015 a Plot Plan and Preliminary/Final Subdivision Plat (2nd Minor Division in a Calendar Year) was approved creating a 1.18+/-acre lot for the Dollar General Store on Highway 130.

Access: The subject parcel fronts Blue Creek Road for approximately 659'. Blue Creek Road is a County Road with a 50' ROW and an asphalt surface. The parcel also fronts Highway 130 for 139'feet. Highway 130 is a State Highway with a forty (40) ROW and an asphalt surface.

Utilities A six (6) inch water line runs along the west side of Blue Creek Road and a six (6) inch water line runs along the east side of Highway 130, according to David Stafford with Winchester Springs/Center Grove Utilities. Potable water is provided by Winchester Springs/Center Grove Utilities. Power is provided by the Duck River Electric Membership Corporation. Sanitary waste disposal is assumed to be by individual septic tank systems.

Fire Protection: Fire protection service is provided by the North Franklin County Volunteer Fire Department. There is a fire hydrant located approximately 836' north and 687' south of the property line on Highway 130. There are no fire hydrants in the general area on Blue Creek Road.

Other Public Services: Police protection is provided by the Franklin County Sheriff's Department.

Drainage/Flood: Drainage is generalized to the northern center of the parcel where there appears to be a ponding area, according to the USGS Quad Map. The site is not in an identified FEMA flood hazard area per Map No. 47051C0040E.

Area Characteristics: The immediate area is characterized by agricultural activities with residential and commercial activities along the roadways. The general area is characterized by residential and commercial activities along the roadways with scattered agricultural activities beyond.

Comprehensive Growth Plan: The site is located within the Franklin County Planned Growth Area (PGA).

Other: The applicant is proposing the development of a residential subdivision. It is unknown at the time of this writing as to how many lots the applicant is proposing.





It is exciting to advise that Franklin County Reentry ended the year of 2023 with double success. 55 individuals were closed successful and 26 were closed unsuccessful. This is a very positive move in the right direction. In addition, Certified Production Technician training was provided in 23 through partnership with the Tennessee College of Applied Technician. This class will be offered again starting January, 16th, 2024. This training was no cost to Franklin County Reentry as all of expense was reimbursed by Workforce Investment Opportunity Act. Post secondary training enhances the skill level of individuals while incarcerated. Two main features of the training, is a self-esteem builder for the client and advancement in wages when employed upon release. Reentry will continue to encourage incarcerated individuals toward post-secondary education.







This is to outline the services that shall be rendered by the Provider to the County, fees collected and violations to be submitted via email by the provider in a timely manner and shall not waiver unless written consent from both parties occur and shall not take effect until 30 days after the agreement, unless change is imminent to the success of the program. If at any time the county or provider chooses to terminate this program, either party must give written notice and allow at least ninety (90) days to transition out of the program. Any violation of the program by a participant will be submitted to the county designee. Once filed, it will be the duty of the county to determine whether to impose a sanction or a violation of probation or juvenile services. With each program product, there will be fees assessed to the participant. Each participant or County Entity or Employer shall follow these fees.

- a. \$10 per day (offender pay)
- b. \$8 per day (county pay/employer)
- c. \$20/GPS/Month-Consumables if removed daily
- d. \$125 GPS Wireless Chargers(county/employer pay)
- e. \$75 Wired Charger Replacement due to damage
- f. \$150 Wireless Charger Replacement due to damage
- g. Includes installation/Removal during business hours(county/employer pay)

All Programs have a \$100 enrollment fee in which the offender will pay within the first 30 days of service. No offender will be left in jail for not having their enrollment fee at time of release. Offenders will be responsible for past due balances prior to installation plus new fees prior to release. Scheduled County Installations have no enrollment fee.



Program Options by Charges

The following will be a format to cross reference when setting a <u>condition of bail</u>, <u>pretrial</u> <u>release</u>, O.R. bonds or the the court.

This guide is only a template and is not a mandatory pre-set for every offender charged with a crime in the county. The tools laid out in this program are here to enhance public safety, reduce jail overcrowding, save taxpayers money and hold offenders accountable.

Each participant will sign an agreement understanding the rules of services offered by the provider. If a participant wishes to not enroll in the program then the court shall be noticed.



Service Agreement for County & Employer Paid Monitors

- Payment by County or Employer must be assigned prior to installation of devices.
- Inmates with victims must have victim exclusion zones and contact information. The County is responsible for providing victim information to the provider.
- The County is responsible for notifying the victim of the released inmate and the conditions to the release.
- Zones restrictions must be set and provided to the provider prior to installation of GPS.
- Alerts generated by the system are assigned by the provider and provided by the county prior to installation of GPS. Alerts are systems generated by text and/or email.
- County/Employer will be billed on the 1st business day of each month. Invoice is due within 30 days of receipt.
- Payment methods accepted: Check or Credit Card

This program will be in place for a period of one (1) year with auto renewal of five (5) years. All participants who are ordered to enroll in one of the above programs shall enroll with the provider.

The provider shall provide proper employment to ensure efficiency in the program. Each employee shall provide a background check proving the employee has no felonies on record and submit to random drug screens as required by the Drug Free Workplace Act. The employee shall remain in good overall standing with the criminal justice system.

WHEREAS, there is a Consolidated Communications Board and an Emergency Services Committee of the Franklin County Commission whose services and responsibilities overlap and both are not necessary and are not efficient; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission and County officials feel that the Consolidated Communications Board and the Emergency Services Committee should be dissolved and replaced by a combination committee which would serve in both capacities and be more effective and efficient, to be known as the Public Safety Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Tennessee, meeting in its regular session on this 16th day of January, 2024, as follows:

- 1. The Consolidated Communications Board and the Emergency Services Committee shall be and hereby are abolished and dissolved.
- 2. There is hereby created a Public Safety Committee of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.



Because of the variety of county services, all county employees may not observe holidays on the same day. If your work schedule requires a deviation from the holiday schedule, your Supervisor will tell you about it.

Holidays within Vacation Period: When an authorized holiday falls within an employee's vacation period, an additional day of vacation shall be provided.

Sick Leave

- I. Sick leave is earned at the rate of one (1) day per month for a total of 12 days per year. Sick time is not accrued unless the employee works a minimum of 20 hours per month or is on paid leave; i.e. vacation, sick, or comp time. There is no maximum accumulation of sick leave credits. Accumulated sick leave has no value except for the purpose granted. Unused sick leave shall be credited as creditable service under the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System.
- 2. Upon return from three day's illness, the employee must furnish a physician's statement to verify illness. Abuse of sick leave will be grounds for termination. *If no leave is available, a physician's statement will be required.
- 3. Employee's Accumulated SICK LEAVE may be used per year for illness of employee's
