- Tonnages for recycling are up for the year. Cardboard is down just slightly. It appears the trend of new people to our area and an increase in recycling participation is the cause. Everyday someone calls or comes by the office wanting information and supplies on starting home recycling. Please continue to encourage recycling.
- I have attended classes in Swana and Tswda.
- Waste tonnages appear to be the same which is good considering the annual cost to dispose of waste has increased.

2nd Quarter Report FY 2025-2026

- Our Excell baler that is 25 years old is starting to give us a lot of trouble. I have applied for a recycling equipment grant to help us with replacing our old baler. We did receive the recycling equipment grant and Andrea and I will have the PMC meeting with TDEC on February 2 2026. We did receive the organic management grant for the tractor truck and walking floor trailer.
- We also purchased our on hydraulic and air lines machine from Kimball Midwest with all the different dies to do all sizes of hoses up to 2". This should help us with down time, and getting the equipment back up and running.
- I am still looking at all options for waste services in the future and keeping our costs down.
- We have some equipment that has been deemed surplus so that we can sale on .gov. 2010 Sterling Roll off truck not running, 2000 Navistar International tractor truck, 2020 gooseneck trailer that hasn't been used, Toyota fork lift that has cylinder's bad on it. We are hoping to get enough from the sale of these items to purchase a truck for hauling lawnmower during mowing season and possibly a new commercial lawnmower to replace our old mower that has had 2 engines put on it.

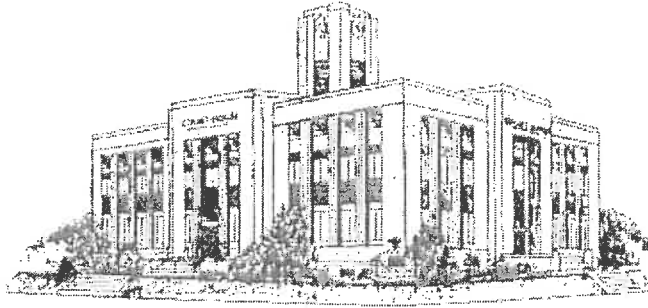
1st Quarter Report FY 2025-2026
